

Dormex[®] and Shirlan[®] Compatibility Update 2007

DO NOT Tank Mix DORMEX with Canola Oil or Mineral Oil

Canola & Mineral oils are used as aids to penetration and to improve the activity of sulphur. If used with Dormex they may cause excessive penetration into the buds, which could burn them.

Applying Dormex 28 days before budburst, and Sulphur & Oil between budswell and mid to late woolly bud stage for rust mite control may be possible but this hasn't been trialled so Crop Care cannot recommend it.

Shirlan, Sulphur & Canola oil (eg Supastik) for Control of Phomopsis & Rust Mite

Applying Shirlan 4 weeks prior to Budburst and then applying Sulphur & Canola oil between budswell & mid to late woolly bud stage should not cause any problems.

BUT DON'T TANK MIX THEM TOGETHER

Dormex mixed with Shirlan for Uniformity and Phomopsis Control

Dormex can be tank mixed **BUT DON'T use Oil**. Only use Shirwet 600 wetting agent. Dormex used alone can be mixed with Shirwet 600 to ensure thorough wetting of the vines.

Shirlan used alone can be mixed with 2% winter or summer oil (mineral oil) to assist in coverage & penetration.
